(Changes to the By-Laws)



Proposition 1 - §1.5. Transparency

Motivation:

The JSU Organisational Rules are a master document that outlines the internal rules, processes, and structures governing the work of Jönköping Student Union.

According to Chapter 2 §1.3, the Organisational Rules are adopted at the constituting board meeting. However, the board's official mandate begins on 1 July, which is usually almost two months after the Annual General Meeting. This creates a practical challenge, as the current rules require the Organisational Rules to be published within two months after the Annual General Meeting, even though the constituting meeting — where they are decided — may take place later. To avoid this procedural gap and ensure a realistic and transparent timeline, To avoid this procedural gap and ensure a realistic and transparent timeline, the deadline for publishing the Organisational Rules should instead be no later than two months after the constituting board meeting.

The Board proposes that the General Meeting approves the following change in the Rules and conduct in Chapter 2, §1.5 Transparency, Row 228, 229.

§1.5. Transparency

The following steering documents must be made available online to all members of JSU no later than 2 months after the Annual General Meeting. These are the steering documents:

- By-Laws
- Organisational Rules
- Plan of Operations
- Budget
- Letter of Opinion

To:

§1.5. Transparency

The following steering documents must be made available online to all members of JSU no later than 2 months after the Annual General Meeting **with the exception of the Organisational Rules, which must be made available no later than two months after the constituting board meeting.** These are the steering documents:

- By-Laws
- Organisational Rules
- Plan of Operations
- Budget

Proposition 2 - §4.4.1. Constituting Board Meeting

Motivation:

The board's mandate starts on the 1st of July. Currently, we are required to hold our constituting meeting before our mandate has begun (by June 30th), which means we are making decisions about rules we will be working under without yet having the formal authority to do so. Moving the deadline to July 30th means we can hold the meeting during our actual mandate period, allowing the board to begin its work properly and without procedural gaps

The Board proposes that the General Meeting approves a change in the constellation of the JSU Board in Chapter 4, §4.4.1 Constellation of the JSU Board, Row 722.

§4.4.1. Constituting Board Meeting
