

**Title:**

Posthumous honorary membership of Fredrik Asp

**Background:**

Fredrik Asp was actively involved in the student movement in Jönköping for more than ten years, between 1994 and 2005. He began his engagement in HiLife and later served two terms as Kårhusgeneral. During this time, he contributed significantly to developing the operations that today form Akademien.

In addition, Fredrik was engaged in the student union council, KRUT (formerly the Pyrotechnical Association), and several other associations. He played an important role in shaping student life and traditions, including contributing to the establishment of the Spring Ball, where he also served as master of ceremonies.

On March 8 this year, Fredrik Asp passed away at the age of 50 after a prolonged illness.

**Motivation:**

Through his long-term commitment, leadership, and contributions to student life, Fredrik Asp had a significant impact on the development of the Jönköping Student Union and its community. His efforts influenced generations of students and helped build structures and traditions that remain central to the student union today.

Granting him posthumous honorary membership would be a way to recognize his contributions and preserve his legacy within the organization.
